# Heritage and the establishment of a national concept

#### **Origin:**

AL-Turath Philanthropy Foundation is a private entity founded by His Royal Highness Prince Sultan bin Salman bin Abdul-Aziz Al-Saud in 1417 H (1996 AD) and reestablished twelve years later, as a Foundation registered with the Ministry of Social Affairs, Kingdom of Saudi Arabia, in 1429 H (2008 AD), under Resolution No. (63).

#### Vision:

Preserving and safeguarding the national heritage, both intellectually and materially, as an element central to the culture, that is driven by pride in its past as it looks forward to participating in a bright and future.

#### **Mission:**

To promote awareness of national, Arab and Islamic heritage; to develop national heritage to become a part of human life, and to develop a source of pride in the national identity and culture.

#### **Objectives:**

- 1- Preserving and safeguarding the heritage of the Kingdom of Saudi Arabia in particular and Arabic and Islamic heritage in general.
- 2- Restoring and preserving mosques in their urban character, through the "National Program for Maintaining the Historic Mosques".
- 3- Archiving documentation to serve the national memory through the National Archives of Historic Photographs.
- 4- Encouraging students and professionals to preserve urban heritage, through the Prince Sultan bin Salman Heritage Award Urban.
- 5- Spreading and defining the heritage culture, through the Foundation's programs and periodic publications.



- 6- Promoting heritage in educational curricula through scientific institution's forums and training programs inside and outside the Kingdom.
- 7- Holding forums, seminars, exhibitions and lectures through the Cultural Forum for Exhibitions; To spread knowledge and increase community participation.
- 8- Opening horizons for cooperation and partnership with parties related to heritage inside and outside the Kingdom.
- 9- Supporting institutions and stakeholders that have a relationship with heritage, and cooperating with them in preserving the heritage.
- 10- Stimulating general interest in heritage through specific initiatives, in order to spread knowledge, and develop heritage awareness and encourage preservation.

AI-Turath Philanthropy Foundation has worked - for years - to motivate those who have an interest in heritage, AI-Turath works for itself, as well as for the benefit of specialized bodies, whether governmental or private.



#### **National Archives of Historic Photographs**

The image is one of the most important means of authentication. It is the prime source of scientific, scholarly and Historic documentation. It stands alongside archaeological finds, urban evidence, manuscripts, digital statistics, audio recordings, animated films, and oral narrative as evidence and Historic corroboration.



The image has a unique ability to reflect many aspects of life. Al-Turath Philanthropy


Foundation was keen on employing the power of the image in this area, by contributing to the King Fahd National Library project; to create a national archive, comprised of a wide range of rare Historic images chronicling the stages of life in the development of the Kingdom, when photography was in its infancy.

Great efforts were made to gather information about the history of photography, and its patrons in the Arabian Peninsula. Eventually, the stages of the collecting this important heritage culminated in the creation of a unique and invaluable national archive.

Regarding the importance of the Historic documentation, AI-Turath Philanthropy Foundation proposed the idea of establishing a national archive to the Custodian of the Two Holy Mosques King Salman Bin Abdul-Aziz AI-Saud when he was the Governor of Riyadh Province, General Supervisor of King Fahd National Library, and Chairman of the Supreme Committee. The archive was to celebrate 100 years since the unification of the Kingdom and to create a "National Archive for Historic Images" at the King Fahd National Library in Riyadh. This archive was to be a source of distinct and notable Saudi history reflecting cultural and educational elements emanating from the Kingdom's past, and to be a reference bank documented for the benefit of researchers and scholars and those interested in Saudi Arabia's history.

Practical steps announcing the establishment of the National Archive for Historic Photographs, through the sponsorship of the Custodian of the Two Holy Mosques, may Allah protect him, began during the official opening ceremony of the King Fahd National Library on the fifth of Ramadan 1417 H (1997 AD). This led to the issuance of the Royal Court's approval to establish a National Archive for Historic images at King Fahd National Library. The library was to take advantage of modern technologies to preserve historic images of the Kingdom of Saudi Arabia, processing them, and facilitating access to them through sophisticated electronic systems.

The Foundation has so far implemented the first stage of the national archive's plan amounting to 30 thousand images. It also has implemented the second stage, which included 14 thousand images for the King Fahd national library, collected from various sources within and outside the Kingdom.





















#### Archives of King Khalid's Images

The King Khalid Foundation, is intent on documenting the heritage of King Khalid, mercy be upon him, to underscore for future generations his legacy to the homeland, in the various positions of responsibility he attained during his life. This will come through the publication of an illustrated book, which will document the most important stages in the life of the departed King, a life rich in achievements at the local and international levels.


Al-Turath Philanthropy Foundation contributed in preparing the archives of King Khalid's images along with its efforts to complete the National Archive of Historic Photographs, which deals with the monarchs of the Kingdom, and senior figures from across different regions of the realm. For each monarch, the archives feature a documented biography with images of the stages of his life.



#### The Institute of The Capital

The history of establishing the Model Capital Institute began when King Abdul Aziz, gave the order to allocate a portion of his palace for the education of his children. This was to be the nucleus for the establishment of the Institute.

In 1360 H (1940 AD) and throughout his reign, King Saud, allocated a building in Nasiriyah Palace, with the name AI-Anjal institute for this purpose, and so the Institute witnessed a revival, and began to attract large numbers of students among princes and others from different regions of Saudi Arabia.

AI-Turath Philanthropy Foundation mounted, at the Model Capital Institute, the Historic photo archive, launched on 13th Rabei Al-Awal 1427 H (April 11, 2006 AD), under the patronage of His Royal Highness Prince Ahmed Bin Abdul-Aziz, the Vice Interior Minister -at that time- and the head of the Graduate Association at the Institute. The Graduate Association took the decision to name the Archive after His Royal Highness Prince Sultan Bin Salman Bin Abdul-Aziz, in recognition of his adoption of the idea.



# Introduction

Registering the Islamic Architectural Heritage Around the World

The Research Centre for Islamic History, Art and Culture (IRCICA), subsidiary of the Organisation of Islamic Cooperation (OIC) maintains a database relating to the Islamic sites and monuments which constitute the architectural heritage of the Muslim world.

This major initiative was made possible thanks to the generous sponsorship of H.R.H. Prince Sultan Ibn Salman Ibn Abdulaziz, Secretary General, Supreme Commission for Tourism, and Founder-President, Heritage Foundation (Al-Turath), Kingdom of Saudi Arabia. The program to establish a database was included in the work plans of IRCICA starting from 2006 and commended by the Islamic Conference of Foreign Ministers and the Islamic Conference of Tourism Ministers in their various sessions.



The database program aims to register the Islamic archeological and architectural heritage assets around the world, depict them by recording comprehensive information on their history and present state, their environment, physical plan and features, past and present functions, restorations done, etc., and by that way, to contribute to their preservation, development and promotion worldwide. The database includes all sorts of information, in a way to meet the needs of all research disciplines and sectors of activity – archeology, architecture, tourism, etc. Establishment and maintenance of the database will involve regular updating. Focal points will be designated by each country, to provide necessary information on their sites and monuments to IRCICA through an interactive on-line process.

In addition to data collected and elaborated by IRCICA, information is collected and provided to IRCICA by the government institutions and non-governmental organizations in charge of dealing with preservation of monuments in OIC member countries, and in other countries having Islamic architectural heritage. These data will be processed in the Central Base Unit operated by IRCICA using the internationally adopted criteria for the selection and collation.

The Database shall be treated as set of digital information to be kept in the Internet which would include detailed information about up to 100000 Islamic architectural heritage monuments to be entered in an estimated period of ten years. The information will include descriptions of geographical location, photographs and plans, facts and figures, assessments of present condition and future prospects, for each monument.

# About the Program

- Taking into consideration acquired experiences, technology development and enlargement of the database, the program is under permanent improvement and upgrading.

- The program is an Web based system – it can be accessed by anyone, anywhere, anytime; it is open to public, up to date, user-friendly, integrated, scalable, reliable, centralized; and has widespread usage, mostly current information, and live updates.

- The program makes use of a G.I.S.-based system – all properties are geographically based; the properties can be seen on maps and satellite images based on satellite links. A small set of data with one image is accessible on the Google Map and similar programs.

- There are four data levels of dossier for each property: (a) Basic Data; (b) Property per se; (c) Property in Urban context; (d) Supporting documents- digital library and archive.

- The basic level is fully accessible for anyone. Other levels are accessible for registered users, partners in the program, or interested parties affiliated to research institutions or projects.

Registration will be regulated by protocols or agreements.

The aim is to register 100000 properties by incorporating data to be supplied by the OIC member countries' concerned institutions, during a period of ten years.

## Implementation Mode

- The Central Base Unit operated by IRCICA will be connected to the focal points to be designated by the Member States and in other countries which have Islamic heritage assets.

- The Central Base Unit will be capable of providing different interfaces for different levels: project management, data entry, editorial work, approval of publishing and viewing. The data, map and internet servers are located at IRCICA, Istanbul.

- The Member State Unit should be responsible for content creation and entry using the online questionnaire and will have remote access for data entry.

- Regional Sub-Centers should be established at a later development phase to deal with specific aspects of heritage in the regions.

## **Program Objectives**

- To properly document the Islamic Architectural Heritage and making it available to all interested parties.

- To create a set of recommendations for preservation and development services integrating tourism industry and supporting activities (e.g. agricultural and use of alternative energies).

- To develop education and training in the fields related with program activities.

- To support development of arts and crafts program related to specific sites as the main contribution to tourism development.

- To support identification of key themes and regions where heritage is under-represented, their nomination and documentation and review and selection processes.


- To support post-listing assistance and outreach to site management.

- To present heritage globally through: Internet services, TV news programs, Publications, Seminars, Promotion of selected destinations through business and political meetings.


- To establish 'The Virtual Museum of Islamic Arts' aiming to connect virtually architectural monuments with its dislocated artifacts.

- To propose accesses, virtual and physical, to monuments througt set up of regional hubs for communication.

- To prepare Hypothetical Tourist Routes: regional types, following important historic events, trade roads, Hajj routes, etc.









## **National Program for the Preservation of Historic Mosques**

His Royal Highness Prince Sultan bin Salman bin Abdulaziz Al Saud, when he was the Chairman of the Saudi Commission for Tourism and Antiquities (SCTA), consistent with His Highness's commitment to serving the houses of Allah and Islamic urban heritage, adopted the National Program for the Care of Historic Mosques.

Since its launch in 1417 H (1996 AD), AI-Turath Philanthropy Foundation began to take care of mosques in Saudi Arabia and has also assumed responsibility for documenting and restoring a number of historic mosques in all regions and villages of the Kingdom.

The charitable reconstruction and restoration of the houses of Allah is important because it revitalizes the historic mosques venerating the many prayers performed there since their foundation and honoring their great impact on the lives of people. The first founders set out from those historic mosques to establish this blessed nation and achieve its national unity. Therefore, AI-Turath Philanthropy Foundation chose to play a major role in the restoration of Historic mosques, allowing them to resume their social and religious functions and remind future generations of how the mosques were the basis for all that is good, thanks to Allah. The Custodian of the Two Holy Mosques and the Crown Prince continue to show great interest in preserving the Historic heritage of mosques throughout the country.

The idea of launching the National Program for the Preservation of Historic Mosques is the result of a vision conceived by His Royal Highness Prince Sultan bin Salman bin Abdulaziz, in collaboration with the then Minister of Islamic Affairs, Endowments, Da'wa and Guidance, presented to His Royal Highness Prince Sultan Bin Abdulaziz, then Crown Prince, Second Deputy Prime Minister, Minister of Defense and Aviation, and Inspector General. HRH Sultan bin Abdulaziz approved the sponsorship of the program for the preservation, reconstruction, restoration, and documentation of the history of mosques on 19 Jumada I 1425 H (13 August 2005 AD). HRH provided support for the first phase of the program. After the success of the program in the restoration of a number of mosques, HRH directed that the National Program be presented as a gift to the Ministry of Islamic Affairs, Endowments, Da'wa and Guidance. At that time, the name "National Program for the Preservation of Historic Mosques" was adopted for the program.

The scope of work includes the inventory of historic mosques, the development of a scientific plan to document them, and the restoration in a proper way that ensures the preservation of the mosque's urban character. The work will be done in accordance with the priorities of restoration, timetable, and allocated budget for the restoration of the identified mosques. In addition, an endowment that supports the future maintenance of mosques must be established.

Next, AI-Turath Philanthropy Foundation with the participation of the Ministry of Islamic Affairs, Endowments, Da'wah and Guidance carried out tasks related to the implementation of this program in accordance with a precise plan of action, which was divided into successive phases. In the first phase, the Ministry provided the AI-Turath Philanthropy Foundation with available information about the mosques of interest.

In turn, the AI-Turath Philanthropy Foundation selected mosques with distinct urban and Historic characteristics and presented a list of these mosques to the Ministry for approval. Once the mosques received approval, they were added to the main list of mosques to be restored.

The program received the support of the Custodian of the Two Holy Mosques King Salman bin Abdul Aziz. Prince Sultan bin Salman bin Abdul Aziz announced the restoration of the historic Hanafi Mosque in historic Jeddah, where King Abdulaziz prayed, and also the restoration of a number of historic mosques in Al-Madinah Al-Munawwarah. His Royal Highness also revealed the sponsorship of the Custodian of the Two Holy Mosques for a special program for the preservation of mosques in the vicinity of the historic Ad Diriyah, which includes the restoration of 34 historic mosques, to be completed by the General Authority for Tourism and National Heritage, the Ministry of Islamic Affairs, Endowments, Da'wah and Guidance.

Following is a number of AI-Turath Philanthropy Foundation's achievements:

- The study and restoration of Al-Baiya Mosque in Makkah al-Mukarramah with the support of the Ministry of Islamic Affairs, Endowments, Da'wah and Guidance.
- The restoration of Al-Saghra Mosque in Al-Ula In Al-Madinah Al-Munawwarah region, and Al-Zawiya Mosque in Yanbu with the support of Prince Sultan bin Salman bin Abdulaziz. Al-Turath Philanthropy Foundation prepared documentation and restoration studies for the seven mosques and completed the study and restoration of Abu-Bakr Al-Sadiq and Umar ibn Al-Khatab mosques, as well as Al-Ghamama Mosque, with the support of Al-Manakha Company.

A number of histor mosques were renovated in Riyadh province, where Princess Sultana bint Ahmed al-Sudairi, may God have mercy on her, supported the restoration of Al-Awshazah mosque in Al-Ghat Furthermore, HRH Prince Sultan bin Salman bin Abdulaziz supported the construction of HRH Prince Ahmed bin Salman bin Abbdulaziz God bless his soul in Khuzama neighborhood in addition to his support for the restoration of three mosques in the historic Ad Diriyah:, namely Al- Zowaihra Mosque, Al- Seraiha Mosque, and Al-Dawasser Mosque. Al- Murih Mosque in the Historic Ad Diriyah and Al- Rmeileh Mosque in the center of Riyadh as well as the Qarashah Mosque in Hareemla were also restored. In addition, Al-Hussaini mosque in Shaqra was restored by local people.

 In Tabab, Asir, The Custodian of the Two Holy Mosques, King Abdullah bin Abdulaziz, God Bless His Soul, when he was crown prince, supported the restoration of the Imam Saud bin Abdulaziz bin Mohammed bin Saud Mosque.

In the Eastern Province six mosques were restored:, namely Jawatha Mosque in Al-Ahsa, Hassan Mosque in Bataliya, Al-Aqir Mosque in Al-Aqir Port, Al-Tuhimiyyah I Mosque and Al-Tuhimiya II Mosque in Al-Tuhimiya Village, and Hamad Al-Majdal Mosque in Juna Island, with the support of the Royal Commission for Jubail and Yanbu. In addition, in Al-Ahsa, Al-Jabri Mosque was restored with the support of Sheikh Abdul Latif bin Mohammed Al-Khatib.

Within the framework of cooperation a joint agreement was signed between the General Authority

for Tourism and National Heritage, the Ministry of Islamic Affairs, Da'wah and Guidance, and the Heritage Charity Foundation, in Jumada I 1433 H (April 2012 AD), with the aim of coordinating efforts to complete the projects of the National Program for the Preservation of Historic Mosques.


As part of its efforts in this program, AI-Turath Philanthropy Foundation organized a number of field tours to various regions of the Kingdom to survey Historic mosques and evaluate them for restoration, resulting in the publication of a book entitled "National Program for Historic Mosques" in 1437 H (2016 AD), as a scholarly effort to document these mosques

Currently, since 2018, Al-Turath Philanthropy Foundation is studying the restoration of 13 mosques in Historic Jeddah for the benefit of the General Authority for Tourism and National Heritage, within the program of reconstruction of Historic mosques, namely: Hasoubah Mosque, Ghuloom Mosque, Al- Khaish Mosque, Al-Amoudi Mosque, Al- Magrabi Mosque, Sonbol Mosque, Al-Fattan Mosque and Al-Burkhali Mosque , Al Baraka Mosque, Salmaniya Mosque, Bin Mahfouz Mosque, Akash Mosque, and Bilal Bin Rabah Mosque.


Within the framework of the cooperation agreement signed with the General Authority for Tourism and National Heritage in Jumada I 1433 (April 2012), AI-Turath Philanthropy Foundation organized a number of workshops dealing with the restoration of historic mosques, with the participation of experts and in keeping with the highest standards and methods of the trade.

Following are achievements of AI-Turath Philanthropy Foundation in the National Program for the Preservation of Historic Mosques in the Kingdom of Morocco:



# **Al-Turath Training Programs**

AL-Turath Philanthropy Foundation offers specialized training courses in all fields of heritage, with the intent to qualify individuals with creative skills for restoring, rehabilitating and maintaining heritage buildings. The foundation organized training courses throughout the past two decades, which were delivered by international experts offering innovative experiments in the field of restoring and preserving heritage. These courses enabled the Foundation to improve the performance of young individuals and to raise skill levels while creating strong relationships among them, thus settingthe opportunity for further cooperation and communication.

AI-Turath Philanthropy Foundation has signed a strategic partnership agreement with the Research Center for Islamic History, Arts and Culture (IRCICA), and a number of universities and institutions of interest; to establish a training program in the spring and summer. This program is concerned with research and studies on urban heritage sites and documentation, and provides technical support for projects to develop urban heritage, and for the development of methods of social and economic impact assessment, and economic solutions. The program benefits from the Prince Sultan Bin Salman Urban Heritage Database. The program prepares junior and specialized students to be able to upgrade the concepts of preserving urban heritage at various educational and government levels. It serves municipal, university and all practitioners in the field of urban heritage conservation.







## **Al-Turath Publishing**

AI-Turath Philanthropy Foundation published a wide range of books around the subject of heritage encompassing Saudi, Arab, Islamic or more generally human heritage, reflecting its interest in translating books dealing with heritage in all its various aspects. As a part of this effort, AI-Turath Philanthropy Foundation published a series of documentary books about the kings of Saudi Arabia, highlighting aspects of their personalities and achievements in various fields of endeavor.

The Foundation has also produced books on the history of the Kingdom of Saudi Arabia, its regions, the stages of its development, customs and traditions, and cultural and civilizational heritage in general. They are a record of the impressions of explorers and seasoned travelers and their memoirs about the country and include anecdotes and pictures of the Arabian Peninsula taken during Historic times. The production of these books was a result of either an initiative or funding from the foundation or by the other sectors interested in documenting the heritage of the Kingdom and the achievements of its civilization.

AI-Turath Philanthropy Foundation's oversight committee was keen to examine and audit the books before they were published to ensure that the books have a direct correlation with the history and heritage of the Kingdom. The books published by the Foundation have covered various regions of the Kingdom, where contribution was made to its history by events and notable individuals who have travelled through and observed these areas.

The books published by AI-Turath Philanthropy Foundation, whether in Arabic or English present novelty, depth, richness of information, scientific discourse, as well as the idiosyncratic observations of the travelers which are by definition personal yet give a close-up picture of life on the Arabian Peninsula at the time when information and documentations was scarce.

AI-Turath Philanthropy Foundation published a number of books, each of which has closely defined targets, and ensuring that the heritage dimension features in them.

The Foundation was in charge of publishing the 'Arrivadh Magazine' for years, and has worked to develop it to meet the objectives of the Arrivadh Municipality.

AI-Turath also issues a monthly press file, which reports on the heritage news in the Arab and Muslim worlds, utilizing technology industry standards to print digital versions. Thus, publication is an important part of the Foundations aim to meet its objectives in raising awareness of the importance of heritage and its contribution to the dissemination of culture.

## **The Award in Numbers**





## The Logo

His Royal Highness Prince Sultan bin Salman bin Abdulaziz, founder and president of AI-Turath Philanthropy Foundation, conceived with Dr. Ahmed Mostafa the design of the logo for AI-Turath Philanthropy Foundation, which embodies it's identity, and represents an authentic it in a symbol consisting of the following:

- A white frame that takes on a rectangular shape and embraces the date palm, which represents heritage, indicating human awareness of its heritage value.
- Another white frame that matches blends in the words "AI-Turath in the roots".
- The two words "AI-Turath" reflect one another and form the roots of the palm tree.
- A tall palm tree whose branches are formed from the repeated word AI-Turath repeated six times.
- The letters thaa from the word AI-Turath sit like a crown on top of the palm tree.
- A green background expresses AI-Turath space represented by the date palm tree.

Reflecting on the palm tree in the logo, Dr. Ahmed Mustafa says "that good AI-Turath is like a good tree with stable roots and rising to the skies.

As you can see, the word "AI-Turath" is woven into every detail of this palm tree, and all that is linked to it, whether in its soil or

its environment as represented by the space set in bounded by the frame, which in turn reflects human awareness of what he incorporates, in this case it represents the human awareness of the heritage.

Dr. Ahmed Mostafa then added:

"I found it wise to confirm and consolidate this concept of nature, by showing the vertical balance in a way that avoids monotony, I have found - through experience - that placing the letter Thaa in the direction of the axes on which the fronds are attached, creates a visual vitality that is a source of dialogue and appeal with the form, and to to control this vitality a series of these thaa letters were deliberately designed in a manner to indicate growth and sublimity creating a crown quasi invisible at the top of this palm tree, or as if structural skeleton upon which the top of this palm tree is built".
